Angels Tide commences as we approach the Feast of St. Michael and All Angels (September 29) and lasts until All Saints Day (November 01). The Gospel Readings around this time address the spiritual warfare of the church against the devil, the world, and all the principalities and powers of this present evil age.

Our Order of Service

For the Sundays of Angels Tide, we will continue to follow the order of Divine Service Setting One, beginning on page 151 of *Lutheran Service Book*. The bulletin insert will guide you through the service and provide you with the parts that are proper for **The Nineteenth Sunday after Trinity**.

We receive the Lord's Supper every Sunday In joyful obedience to the teaching of Scripture, the congregations of Lutheran Church-Canada practice closed communion. We would like you to commune with us, but because of the different teachings about this sacred meal we want you to know what we believe and confess before showing your agreement as you join us in this communion. Guests who desire to commune with us are thus asked to speak with the pastor to arrange for a time of instruction before giving their public confirmation of what we believe and confess. Everyone who communes should fill out a communion card and leave it in the offering plate before the service.

After their release President Garcia was able to pray with his group and the other 24 people who had been kidnapped before they made their way back to Mexico City. We are deeply grateful to God who delivered our brothers and sisters in Mexico from this serious situation. The Lutheran Synod in Mexico is a member church of the International Lutheran Council, a worldwide association of confessional Lutheran churches, including Lutheran Church-Canada.
